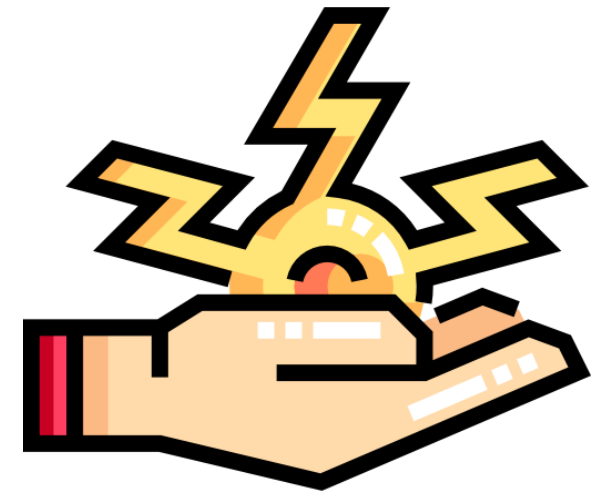
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OBJECTIVES OF CCA EXPERIENCE

WHEN IS THE EXPERIENCE?

Total Number of Sessions: 2

Day & Date: 16th February (Friday) & 23rd February (Friday)

Attire: PE Attire and school shoes. Curriculum as per normal.

Reporting Time: 2.00 p.m. (on both days)

Reporting Venue: Parade Square (on both days)

Dismissal: 4.00 p.m. (on both days)

WHAT WILL THEY EXPERIENCE?

- Your child/ ward will experience 4 CCAs of their choice based on the CCA categories.
- Your child/ ward will have an opportunity to be exposed and experience CCAs within their interest.

- Discuss and guide your child/ ward in making his/ her choices especially during CCA selection exercise after the Primary 3 CCA Experience. Share with them the importance and impact of making informed choices.
- Encourage your child/ ward to try out CCAs he/ she would be interested during the CCA experience as the sessions.

- Refrain from asking your child/ ward to join a CCA he/ she has neither talent or interest for the purpose of DSA.
- Help ensure that he/ she chooses a CCA that he/ she enjoys and has interest/passion/talent in so that the child/ ward
 - can stay committed
 - see himself/ herself growing in it
 - fully benefit the CCA journey until graduation



HOW CAN PARENTS SUPPORT AND HELP IN THIS CCA JOURNEY?

- CCA at primary school is not compulsory but strongly encouraged because it provides them
 - a whole-school experience that promotes camaraderie and team spirit among our students
